



Thanks so much for reviewing the Goodspeed Scout! Wanted to give you some background on the company and this model in particular.

I started Goodspeed back in 2018 and initially launched the Petrol, a quartz chronograph with a Yema Rallygraf style to it. The Petrol raised over \$14,000 on Kickstarter but did not reach the funding goal. Goodspeed's second watch, the Sonoma, was a big success on Kickstarter raising nearly \$28,000. That watch is now nearly sold out.

The Scout is Goodspeed's third watch, and a slight diversion from our first two models (in that it is not a chronograph). The Scout is designed to be a dressy field watch. A watch that can be worn anywhere (under a suit, on a hike, or just running errands) to make it *"That Go Anywhere, Do Anything watch"*.

Scout Specifications:

- Miyota 9039 automatic (no date) movement
- 38.5 mm case width
- Flat sapphire crystal
- 20mm band width
- Lugs will be drilled on production model
- 200m waterproofness with screw down crown
- Watch comes in three colors: Black, Blue and Green

Other items of interest:

- Case back has space for engraving a name or other message
- Crown is signed with the Globe G logo as well as the bracelet clasp --- which matches the globe on the dial
- Hour markers and numerals on the dial are negative space letting the brushed metal dial show through --- small lume pips in the chapter ring
- Kickstarter will launch in mid/late January
